Timberlake Salt Water Boat Launch and Picnic Area

The Timberlake salt water boat launch and picnic area is for Member's, and their guests, use only.

It includes a beach, boat launching site (long tide runout) that makes for excellent boating and fishing and a long dock with picnic bench. This site is gated and members can obtain a key for access by contacting the Office. Key given only to Members not renters or guests.

Directions: Left out of Timberlake onto Agate Road. Continue as Agate turns into E Pickering Road. Left at the "T" intersection then bear right to Timberlake area.


Area is open for use from sun up to sun set. No overnight camping or partying. Members are to be respectful with surrounding homeowners that live adjacent to the Timberlake saltwater lot.

All fishing and shell fish harvesting must be done with proper licenses and in accordance with Washington Fish and Wildlife regulations.

No alcohol on the premises.

Dogs are allowed, they must be leashed.

All children must have an adult present and they too must be respectful and aware of the surroundings.



Members' cars and boats must be identified with either a placard or sticker, that show both are registered with Timberlake.

NO overnight vehicle parking.

NO Boats moored to dock overnight.

Swimming is allowed but there are no life guards on duty. Members must remember that they do so at their own risk. Also, all children must wear life jackets when around the boat launch or on the dock.

Use of the boat launch or the dock is done so at user's own risk and user's are responsible for any damages incurred.
